ONE-DAY PRE- AND POST-CONFERENCE INTENSIVES:

ABALONE AND SEAWEED TEK: OUR ORIGINAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR HARVESTING THE OCEAN will be the one-day pre-conference Traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK) workshop produced by the Bioneers Indigenous Forum. This immensely popular annual event will explore traditional ways of sustainably harvesting the ocean's bounty and managing coastal ecosystems. Through discussion, demonstrations and hands-on activities, California Indian TEK experts will share the importance of intertidal resources to traditional Native diets, clothing manufacturing and ceremonial life and discuss ways to address ongoing threats to these cultural practices.

REGENERATIVE AGRICULTURE: GROWING FOOD, STEWARDING ECOSYSTEMS AND MITIGATING CLIMATE CHANGE will be the post-conference one-day workshop, including a farm tour, presentations by leading experts, and demonstrations at Singing Frogs Farm in Sebastopol, an exemplary no-till organic/regenerative farm that has increased its soil carbon by 400% over 6 years.
